Act to amend the Bengal Village-Chaukidari Act, 1870, in its application to Assam.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bengal Village-Chaukidari Act, 1870, hereinafter referred to as the prin-Bengal Act cipal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing; VI of 1870.

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title, 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Villageextent and Chaukidari (Amendment) Act, 1949. commencement.

- (2) It shall have the like extent as the Bengal Village-Chaukidari Act, 1870, in its application to Bengal Act Assam. VI of 1870.
- (3) It shall come into force on such date as the Provincial Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint.
