

West Bengal Act XXII of 1953

THE CALCUTTA UNIVERSITY (EXTENSION OF TERM OF OFFICE OF FIRST VICE-CHANCELLOR) ACT, 1953.

[Passed by the West Bengal Legislature.]

[Assent of the Governor was first published in the Calcutta Gazette, Extraordinary, of the 11th December, 1953.]

[An Act to provide for the extension of the term of office of the first Vice-Chancellor of the University of Calcutta.]

WHEREAS it is expedient in the public interest to extend the term of office of the first Vice-Chancellor of the University of Calcutta;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Calcutta University (Extension of Term of Office of First Vice-Chancellor) Act, 1953.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 11th day of September, 1953.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1) of section 52 of the Calcutta University Act, 1951, or in any order made thereunder, the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Calcutta appointed under that sub-section and referred to in that Act as the first Vice-Chancellor, shall hold office as the first Vice-Chancellor for a period of two years and six months from the date of his appointment under that sub-section as such Vice-Chancellor.
